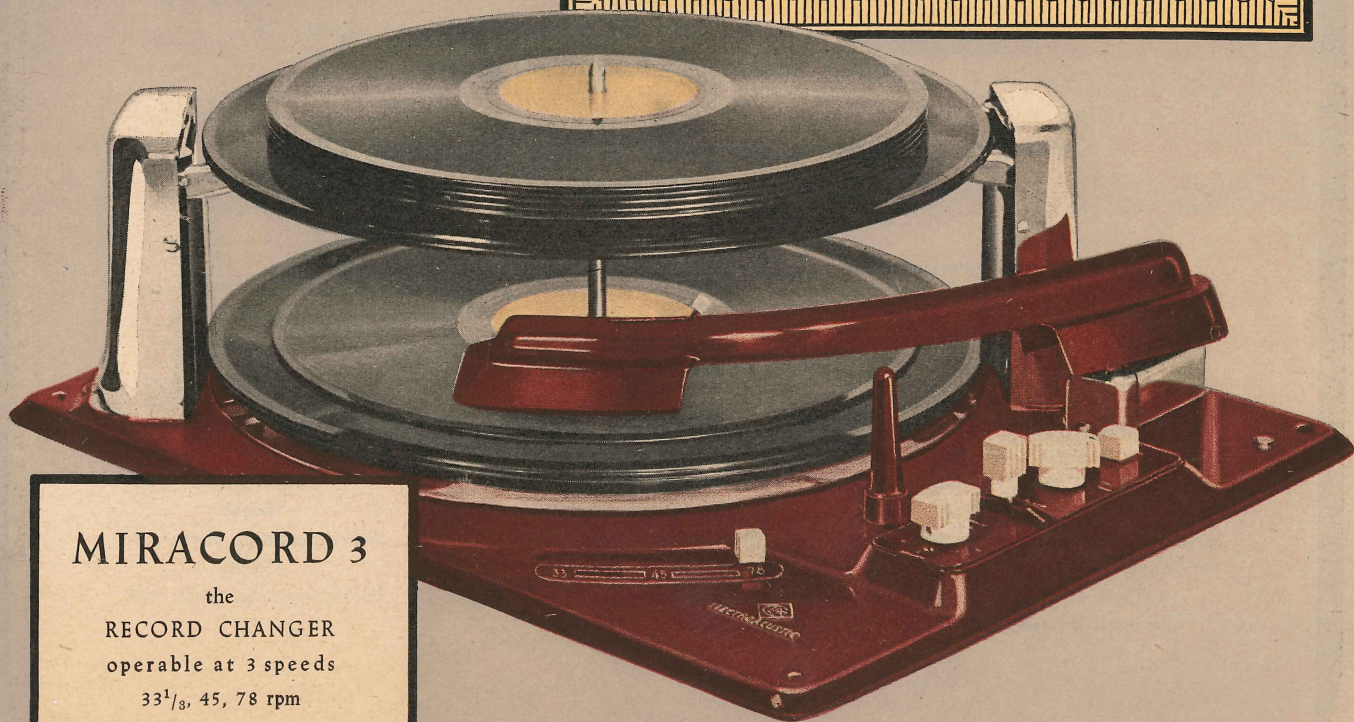

### MIRACORD 3

combines the reliability, excellent finish and versatility of the earlier type of MIRACORD and is improved by the latest developments of modern record player technique

The pick-up is equipped with two separate sapphires, and in order to change from a normal record to a micro-groove (long-playing) record, it is only necessary to switch from one needle to the other without any changing of either needle or system

\*

A new overload-coupling prevents any damage to the instrument arising from wrong handling

\*

The instrument will take from 8 to 12 records of either 10" or 12" Ø, and these can be played in any order desired

\*

A record can be automatically repeated, interrupted, or the instrument will change over to the next record. MIRACORD is also capable of pausing automatically between the records

\*

Owing to the extremely light weight of the pick-up, records will now last much longer

\*

The instrument can also be used as any normal type of gramophone
